### **Spotlight Ministry for April**

#### **"Children's Attention Home"**

The Children's Attention Home is a place of emergency refuge for abused, neglected and abandon children ages birth through 17 years of age from all counties in South Carolina. It provides a temporary home and school for these children until the child's own home conditions are corrected or a permanent home can be found. The Home got its start in 1970 by the Rock Hill Ministerial Association and since that time has cared for more than 6,000 victimized children. For 24 hours every day the Home, through staff and volunteers, provides a secure and loving environment to meet the desperate needs of the 42 children placed in their care. Many times the only love and attention some of these children have ever known was while they lived at the Home. Our church has chosen the Home as one of our outreach ministries and together we can make a difference for these children so that their lives can begin to turn around. ## **Life Builders – English as a Second Language (ESL)**

### **Mission**

To minister Christ's love through teaching Conversational English and working to serve internationals in our community.

### **Theme Scripture**

*The stranger who resides with you shall be to you as the native among you, and you shall love him as yourself; for you were aliens in the land of Egypt: I am the Lord your God. Leviticus 19:33-34*

Often, internationals remain unable to communicate for months or even years after moving to the U. S. This prevents them from getting better-paying jobs, forces them to live in unsafe neighborhoods and makes it a burden to simply survive in a country where they understand so little of the language. Internationals need to know how to fit in to the different aspects of American life. This can include banking, health care, law, safety and many more issues. The Life Builders organization helps build lives by offering English language classes, financial and spiritual assistance.
